WHERE DO THE TUTORING ACTIVITIES TAKE PLACE?

In-person tutoring activities will take place at Building 20 room E every Monday from 14:30 to 16:30. It is mandatory to book by e-mail.

The Tutoring activity can also be carried out in telematic mode (on TEAMS, MEET, ZOOM, etc.), but it is always mandatory to book by e-mail.

WHAT IS A TUTOR?

Tutors are master students or PhD students who:

- 1. They support future students in the transition from school to university and in the process of orientation in the university world, illustrating the contents of the degree courses and providing guidance on the services offered by the University.
- 2. They assist students in the practical organization and acquisition of a valid method of study from the start of their university careers in order to avoid delays.
- 3. They assist first-year students in assimilating into the university's operating systems as quickly as possible (schedules, study plans, exam enrolment, relationships with lecturers, administrative practices, and so on).
- 4. They assist students in increasing their success rate in passing exams by guiding them in collaboration with other tutors.
- 5. At the educational level, they organize study groups and activities that are complementary to teaching and meet the needs of teaching laboratories in order to improve learning quality and reduce the risk of abandonment.
- 6. They will seek the assistance of the Synapse Centre to ensure the student's full personal and social development. Because of its decision-making and financial autonomy, the Synapse Center can ensure a broader and more incisive action for greater psychological support of the student. The coordination with the Synapse Center will be done in total privacy.
